TARDY POLICY

Students are expected to be punctual. A student is considered tardy if he or she is not in their assigned seat when the tardy bell rings. Any running or carelessly walking to their seats while the bell is ringing is considered a tardy. It is up to the teacher's discretion to decide if a student is considered tardy to class.

Tardy Procedures

- 1. If a student is students responsibility to acknowledge the tardy by signing the TARDY BOOK located at the front of the class.
- 2. A detention for dishonesty will be given to those students who do not sign the TARDY BOOK properly and at the time of the infraction.
- 3. Student will immediately go to his/her assigned seat without any classroom disruptions which could result in another detention.
